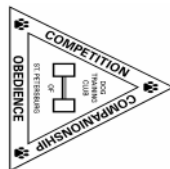

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**THE SAFETY OF DOGS** is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**THE TRIAL WILL BE OPEN** each day from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. **Checks should be made payable to MFACEFDF for Friday and DTCSP for Sat & Sun.** **Entry fee:** \$20.00 first class each dog each day and \$12.00 additional class (as 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> run), same dog, same day (includes \$3.00 per run AKC recording fee).

**Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

**TELEPHONE, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES** cannot be accepted.

**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. **ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

**NO ONLINE ENTRIES ARE BEING TAKEN FOR THESE TRIALS.**

**NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.** Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

**ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

**JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate you.

**TRIAL COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE** for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

**OBSTACLES:** Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

**ELECTRONIC TIMERS** may be used for all classes

**BITCHES IN SEASON** are not eligible to participate. There will be a refund of entries due to bitches which come in season after trial has closed, provided that the owner gives notice in writing to the trial secretary before start of the trial. Subject to \$4.00 fee per class.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES** will be mailed as soon as practicable after trial closes, and will include confirmation notices and judging schedule.

**ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.** Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **All exhibitors must pick up dog waste everywhere on the show grounds.** The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.

**MOVE-UPS:** Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to **the Trial Secretary in writing**. (E-Mail is acceptable.) All move-ups for the weekend must be received by the trial secretary no later than Monday, October 18, 2010 at **6PM**. Day to day move-ups will be accepted over the weekend..

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. **DOGS UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PROHIBITED AT AKC AGILITY TRIALS.**

### **HEIGHT DIVISIONS:**

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

### **DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL:**

Directions from I-75 — Exit 224 (old 43) onto US 301 Westbound. It becomes 10<sup>th</sup> St. West in Palmetto. Continue to 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Turn right on 14<sup>th</sup> and continue to the Fairground Entrance.

Directions from Pinellas County – I-275 south over the Skyway Bridge. Take the first exit (US 19 – Exit 5, old 2) south. ### **T2B Rules Summary**

**COURSE:** A hybrid of Standard and Jumpers with 17-19 obstacles. Will have one or two contact obstacles (no dogwalk), one may be taken twice, 12 weave poles (may be taken twice), no pause table or chute, all jumps except broad jump are permitted.

**CLASS LEVEL:** All dogs will run the same course, regardless of their level. No change of course except for jump height.

**TIME:** No standard course time set. Maximum course time is 50 seconds for 20/24/26"; 55 for 16"; 60 for 4/8/12". Runs over max course time = NQ.

**JUDGING:** Refusals are not called. Any W (wrong course), F, or E result in NQ. Maximum three tries at weave poles are allowed.

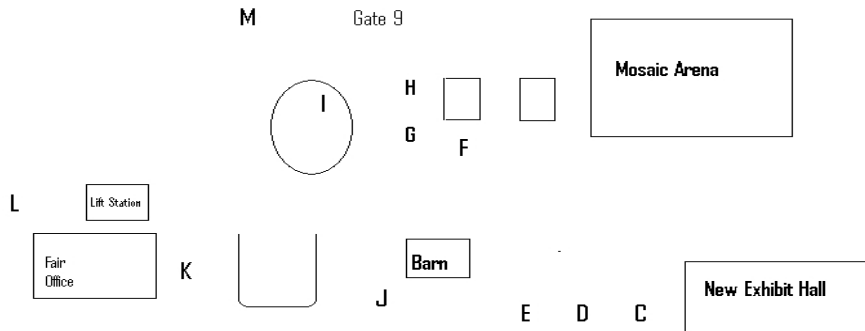
**SCORING:** Each jump height is scored separately. Fastest clean run in each height takes first place, and earns 10 points (toward title, when class becomes official). All clean runs with times up to 10% over 1<sup>st</sup> place earn 9 points; up to 20% over earn 8 points; etc.

**TITLES (eff. 1/1/12):** Require 15 Q's and 100 points. May earn multiple titles (T2B2, T2B3, etc.), but Q's and points do not carry over; the count restarts at 0 each time the title is earned.

## Fairgrounds Camping Map & Information

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners** <sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
